C4.04.01, Statement of Purpose, organizational structure

~~The Congregation is governed by the Congregation Council, which is comprised of no more than 20 elected members. The Standing Committees report to the Congregation Council. Refer to the Continuing Resolutions for a listing of Standing Committees and their purposes. The size of Congregation Council is covered in C12.01 of the Constitution.~~

C8.05.01, Membership, termination of membership

~~Inactivity—There will be no case in which membership is terminated due to inactivity.~~

A member may be removed from the membership roll of the congregation for reasons as provided in the constitution or due to inactivity. Trinity seeks members and prefers that members are active in the life of the congregation. Circumstances under which a member might be considered inactive, as well as a process for removing someone from the membership roster, are outlined in a Continuing Resolution.

C10.01.01, Congregation Meeting

The Annual Congregation Meeting is held during the first month of the Fiscal Year.

C11.01.01, Officers, duties of officers

~~C12.01, Voting Membership of Congregation Council~~

~~The voting membership of the Congregation Council shall consist of the pastor(s), the officers of the congregation, and not more than 20 members nor fewer than 15 members of the congregation. {Remainder of provision in constitution remains unchanged.}~~
