FOOD COLLECTION

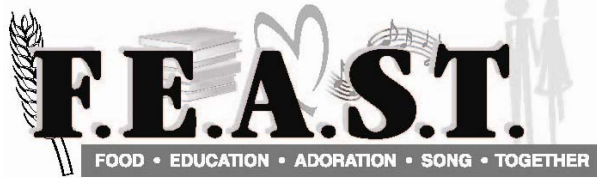
